

## FLY AMERICA ACT WAIVER CHECKLIST

You must complete this form if foreign air travel on a non-U.S. carrier is financed by the U.S. government or will be claimed as a cost under a federal award.

To document a waiver of the restrictions of the Fly America Act under 4 1 CFR Part 301-10, check the applicable statement(s) below. This form should be completed prior to purchasing airline tickets to alleviate any concerns about the allowability of flights taken. Cost and/or personal convenience are NOT included in the exception criteria used to determine the non-availability of a U.S. flag air carrier.

The form should then be signed and attached to the SAP Concur report where the airfare is reported, along with all other supporting documentation.
